RESOLUTION CHANGING THE NON-PARTISAN
NOMINATING PETITION DEADLINE TO COINCIDE WITH
THE STATE OF MICHIGAN NOMINATING PETITION DEADLINE

WHEREAS, the City of Corunna non-partisan nominating petition deadline as printed in Section 3.15 of the City of Corunna City Charter presently states “no later than 4:00 o’clock P.M., E.S.T., on the seventh Monday prior to the date of the city election”; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Corunna desires to change the non-partisan nominating petition deadline to coincide with the State of Michigan nominating petition

deadline, which is “the twelfth Tuesday preceding the odd-year November election” as permitted by MCL 168.644f and 168.644e of Act 116 of 1954 and MCL 117.3b(3) of Act 279 of 1909;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that nominating petitions for the City November General Election shall be filed with the Clerk no later than 4:00 o'clock P.M., E.S.T., on the twelfth Tuesday preceding the odd-year November election and is hereby adopted as recommended.
