

ORDINANCE NO. 02-06

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE CITY OF CORUNNA, MICHIGAN, CHAPTER 2 – ADMINISTRATION, ARTICLE IV. BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS, DIVISION 4. SOFTBALL COMMISSION, BY AMENDING SECTION 2-207. MEMBERSHIP THEREOF.

THE CITY OF CORUNNA, MICHIGAN ORDAINS:

SECTION I. AMENDMENT TO SECTIONS 2-206 (ESTABLISHED) AND 2-207 (MEMBERSHIP), OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF CORUNNA, MICHIGAN, shall be as follows:

Sec. 2-206. Established.

~~A nine-member softball commission for the city is established and hereby created.~~ **There is hereby established a softball commission for the city.**

Sec. 2-207. Membership.

~~(a) — The softball commission heretofore established is continued.~~ shall be appointed by the city council. Membership shall consist of one member from the city council and eight members at large.

- (1) ~~Initial appointment shall be made as follows: two members for one-year terms; three members for two-year terms; three members for three-year terms.~~ **The commission shall consist of seven (7) or nine (9) administrative officers appointed in accordance with section 4.7 (administrative service) of the City Charter for indefinite terms serving at the pleasure of the Council.**
- (2) ~~Terms after the initial appointment terms shall be three years each.~~ The softball commission shall elect from its membership a president, vice-president, treasurer and secretary. **All meetings must have four (4) or five (5) members present relative to the seven (7) or nine (9) membership to enact business.**
- (3) **All members of the softball commission shall serve as such without compensation.** The ~~seven or~~ **seven or** nine-person commission membership shall not include ~~a City Councilperson or the Mayor, the softball league director or administrator, the concessions administrator, parking administrator or any of their assistants.~~ **A majority of the membership shall be comprised of residents or real property owners of the City of Corunna.**
- (4) **Proposed** minutes of the softball commission meetings are to be submitted **to the City Manager within ten (10) business days** at the first city council meeting following the softball commission meeting. **Approved minutes are to be submitted to the City Manager within five (5) days of approval.** ~~(b) — The treasurer may appoint, with the commission approval, his deputy to assist in the functions of the commission treasurer; the deputy need not be a commission member. All meetings must have five members present as a quorum to enact business. (c) — Upon recommendation of the softball commission, the city council may appoint ex officio members to the commission. Such ex officio members may include the softball league director or administrator, the concessions administrator or the parking administrator. The ex officio members so appointed by the city council shall not have a vote at the softball commission meetings, but shall sit only in an advisory capacity.~~
- (5) ~~(d) — When a member of the commission misses two consecutive meetings without excuse, that member automatically forfeits the seat.~~ **Any commission member absent two (2) consecutive meetings or twenty-five percent (25%) of regular meetings in a calendar year, without prior written approval by the City Manager, will be considered for removal from the board. All absences shall be recorded in the meeting minutes.**

- (6) Upon recommendation of the City Manager, the city council may appoint one (1) ex officio member to the commission. The ex officio members so appointed by the city council shall not have a vote at the meetings, but shall sit only in an advisory capacity.
- (7) All Administrative officers shall be responsible to the City Manager in and for the performance of the duties of their office.

SECTION 2. Severability.

This Ordinance and the several sections, sub-sections, paragraphs, clauses and parts thereof are hereby declared to be severable. If any part or clause thereof is declared or adjudged invalid by present or future legislation or decree, the balance of the Ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

SECTION 3. Conflicting Ordinances Repealed.

All Ordinances previously adopted and incorporated in the Code of the City of Corunna, Michigan, through codification procedures, or any existing Ordinances that are inconsistent with the provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, and in the case of inconsistencies, to the extent of such inconsistency, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. Copies Available.

This Ordinance may be purchased or inspected in the City Clerk's Offices, Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.

SECTION 5. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall take effect pursuant to the Corunna City Charter, immediately upon publication hereof.
