

A Proclamation  
Of the Mayor of the City of Corunna, Michigan  
Acknowledging

**MICHIGAN STATE POLICE**

WHEREAS, it is the mission of the Michigan State Police to “provide leadership, coordination, and delivery of law enforcement and support services in order to preserve, protect, and defend people and property, while respecting the rights and dignity of all people;” and

WHEREAS, on April 9, 2002, the ability of the Michigan State Police to efficiently and effectively achieve this mission in Shiawassee County was threatened when Owosso Post #15 of the Michigan State Police was destroyed in a disastrous fire; and

WHEREAS, the personnel of Owosso Post #15 successfully met this challenge, continuing to deliver invaluable law enforcement services to Shiawassee County residents while operating out of temporary space at the Owosso Police Department and later at the Riverwalk Apartments; and

WHEREAS, the Michigan State Police has renewed its commitment to the residents of Corunna and Shiawassee County by occupying a new post facility in Corunna;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED that I, Stephen E. Corey, Mayor of the City of Corunna, Michigan on behalf of all residents of the City of Corunna do hereby welcome First Lieutenant Jerry Ciarlino and the personnel from MSP Post #15 to the City of Corunna today with a presentation of a key to the city as they commemorate the opening of their new post in Corunna; and

BE IT FURTHER PROCLAIMED that I encourage all local citizens to join me in thanking the Michigan State Police and the personnel of MSP Post #15 for their continued presence in Shiawassee County and for their contributions to the health, safety and welfare of the members of the community.
