We will assign spaces in the order we receive them. If you are camping with a group, please send all of the registrations in the same envelope to assure your lots are together. Each camping unit needing a reservation must fill out a form.

You will be contacted by mail or e-mail confirming your reservation. If you must cancel your reservation, please notify us before 4:30 p.m. on July 17 to receive a refund. After that time and date, there will be no refunds given for any reason.

ALCOHOL IS ALLOWED ON THE STU COUTTS PAVILION SIDE OF THE CAMPING AREA. WEAPONS ARE NOT ALLOWED ANYWHERE IN THE CAMPING AREA.
